

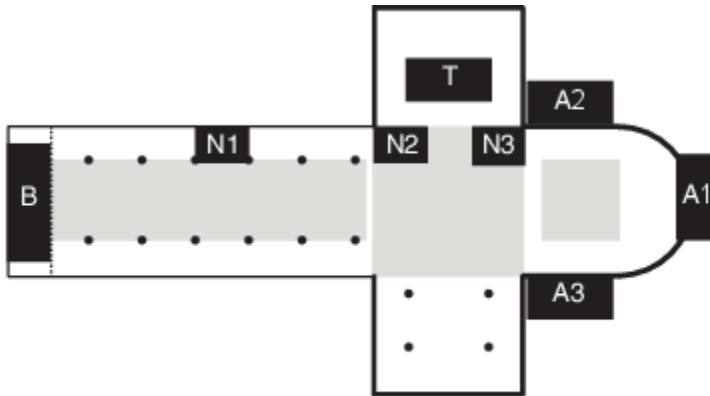
## ERRATA

Page 40: The sentence above the equation and the equation should be changed to read:

For a small omnidirectional source the sound pressure level,  $SPL$ , is given by the sound power level of the source  $PWL$ , the distance from the source  $r$ , and the total sound absorption  $A$  of the room (in metric sabins):

$$SPL \approx PWL + 10 \log \left( \frac{1}{4\pi r^2} + \frac{4}{A} \right)$$
